Fitting Instructions Discovery 2 - Steering Guard

Please read through these instructions before commencing any work.

A - Initial preparation of vehicle before fitting the steering guard

Important - Refer to Owner's Manual before proceeding for safety set up instructions.

- 1. Remove bumper assembly;
 - A Remove the dust shields
 - B Remove bolts from inner wing (one either side)
 - C Remove four central bolts (behind crash cans)
 - D Disconnect light cables and remove bumper.
- 2. Mark position of crash cans on chassis rail with marker or masking tape.
- 3. Chassis rail to crash can; remove 4 nuts & washers, turn bolts around so they are facing inwards to assist fitting steering guard frame thread to be in line with inside edge of crash cans.
- 4. Steering box; remove 2 bolts upper and lower on right hand side.

B - Fitting the steering guard

- 1. Remove blade from the steering guard for ease of fitting.
- 2. Slide steering guard frame into chassis rail and slide the rear up and back to steering box.
- 3. Slide crash can bolts into steering guard frame. Do not fix the nuts yet.
- 4. Loosely fit the 2 new steering box bolts (supplied).
- 5. On the opposite side to the steering box, fit drop bar and buffer plate with steering guard plate (supplied) to chassis using 2 existing steering box bolts (ref section A4).
- 6. Fix 2 new steering box bolts with Loctite (120mm long ref section B4).
- 7. Pinch up all the 8 bolts and check the fitment of the guard.
- 8 Tighten all bolts to Land Rover specification (torque wrench settings).
- 9. Check the crash cans are realigned.
- 10. Fit steering guard blade using the 8 flange bolts (supplied).
- 11. Re-fit bumper.
