
Bush Removal

WARNING


NEVER burn bushes out! There is a danger that the rubber may explode!



Step 1Drill around the bush inner sleeve to remove as much rubber as possible. Turn over and repeat the process.



Step 3Use a hacksaw to saw through the outer sleeve.



Step 2
Use a vice and two sockets to wind the bush centre sleeve through, any remaining rubber will tear.




Step 4Tap out the outer sleeve with a chisel.


For fitment of all new polyurethane bushes that are in two halves with one internal sleeve.




Note

Be careful not to create an air pocket during assembly, the air will just keep popping the second half out as soon as pressure is removed.

Do not start with the sleeve all the way through one half



Step 1Push one half of the bush into the bore.





Step 3
Push in second half of the bush.



Step 4Push sleeve through to second half.
